

HARINGEY WARD PROFILE: BRUCE GROVE



Haringey's Ward Profiles rely on data sources that provide a breakdown to ward-level. Such granular data is less widely available than data at regional or borough level, and as such certain measures use data going back to the 2011 Census. Please be aware of the source and year when using the data cited in this profile.

ATTRIBUTES

SIZE OF WARD (SQ. KM), BRUCE GROVE

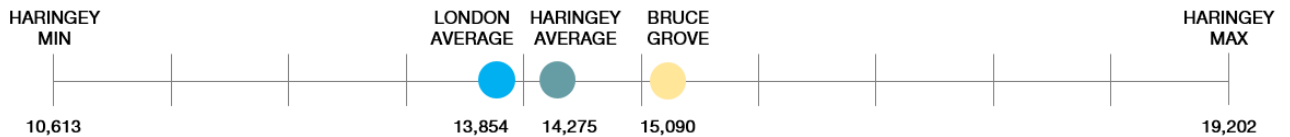
- Bruce Grove is the smallest ward in Haringey, covering 0.9 sq. km.
- This is substantially below both the Haringey (1.6 sq. km.) and London (2.6 sq. km.) averages.

POPULATION, BRUCE GROVE

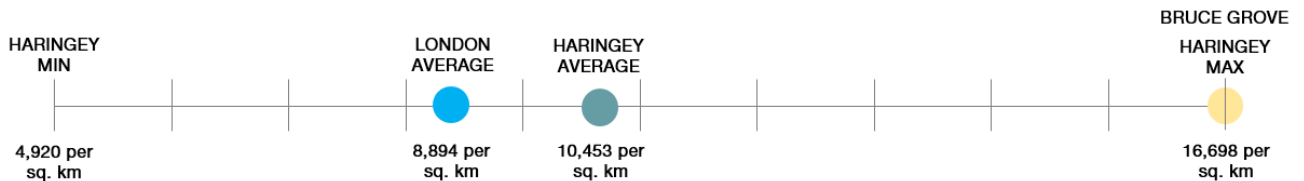
- At 15,090 residents Bruce Grove has a slightly larger population than the average Haringey (14,275) or London (13,854) ward.

POPULATION DENSITY (RESIDENTS PER SQ. KM), BRUCE GROVE

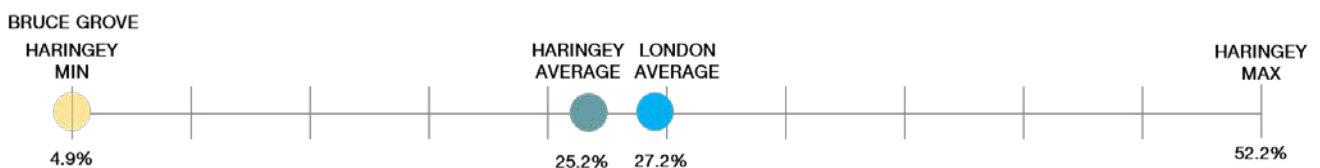
- Bruce Grove is the most densely populated ward in Haringey at 16,698 residents per sq. km. Bruce Grove is significantly more densely populated than the Haringey (10,453) or London (8,894) averages.
- The average Haringey ward is generally more densely populated than the average London ward.

OPEN SPACE, BRUCE GROVE

- Only one fifth (4.9%) of Bruce Grove ward is made up of open space.
- Bruce Grove has the lowest percentage of open space of all wards in the borough, and is also substantially lower than average, at one fifth the Haringey (25.2%) and London (27.2%) averages.

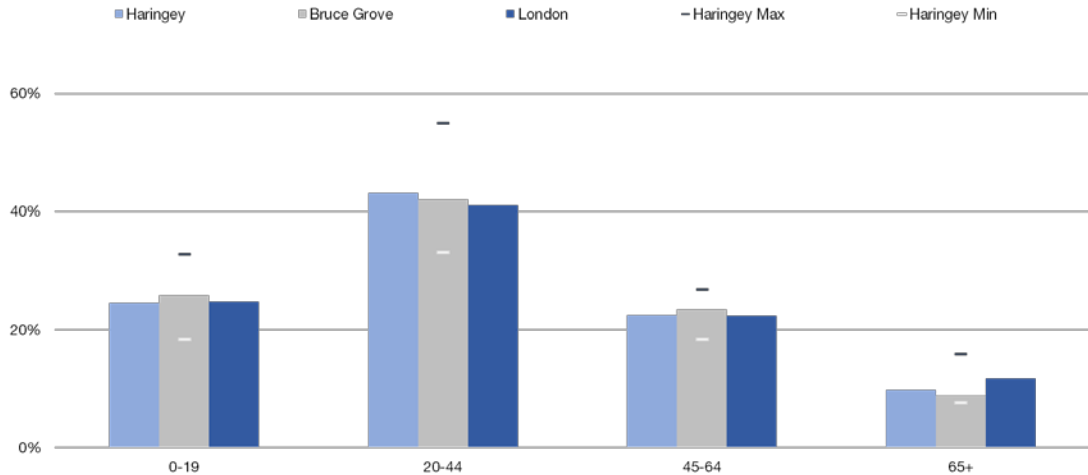

DEMOGRAPHICS

POPULATION AGE, BRUCE GROVE

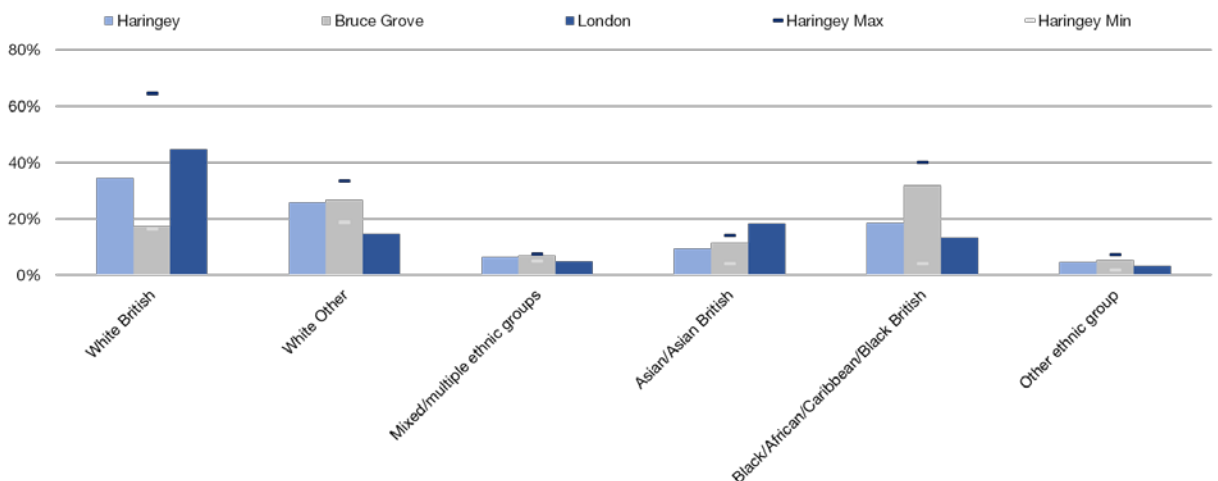
- Bruce Grove's overall population spread mirrors that seen in Haringey more widely, with those aged 20-44 making up the largest proportion of residents (42.1%), and those aged 65+ making up the smallest proportion (8.8%).
- While following the wider borough pattern, the 65+ population is particularly under-represented in Bruce Grove.

ETHNICITY, BRUCE GROVE

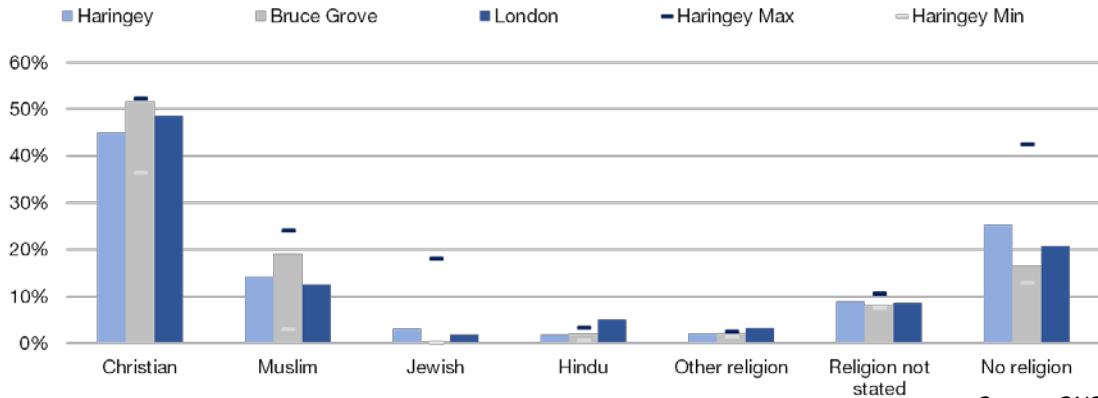
- Bruce Grove has a significantly higher proportion of residents whose ethnicity is Black (31.9%), compared to the wider Haringey population (18.8%). This is the major ethnic group in Bruce Grove.
- White British residents are significantly under-represented in Bruce Grove (17.4%) compared to the Haringey (34.7%) and London (44.9%) averages.

RELIGION, BRUCE GROVE

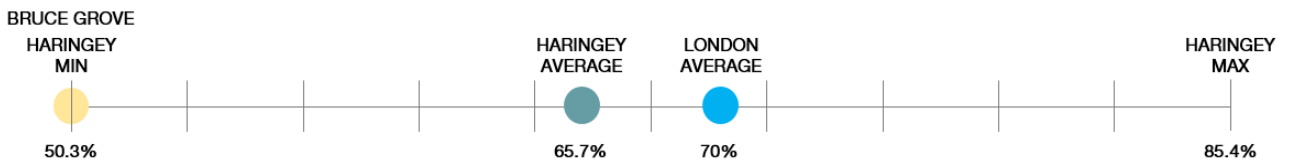
- Compared to the rest of Haringey, Bruce Grove has a larger than average Christian population (51.6%), and among the smallest proportion of Jewish residents in Haringey (0.4%).
- Bruce Grove also has a significantly lower than average population identifying as having no religion (16.6%) compared to Haringey (25.2%).



EDUCATION & QUALIFICATIONS

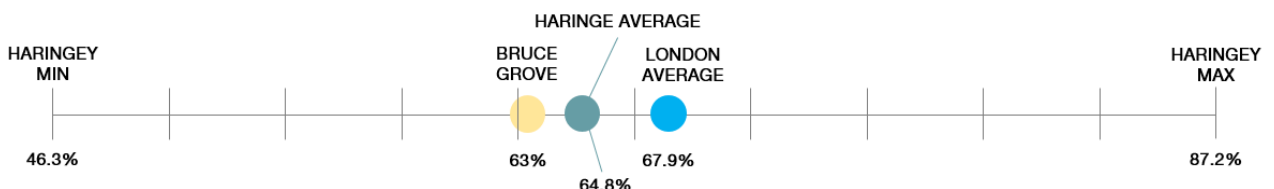
% PUPILS MEETING THE EXPECTED STANDARD AT KEY STAGE 2, BRUCE GROVE

- Bruce Grove has the smallest proportion of pupils meeting the expected standard at KS2 level of all Haringey wards (50.3%).
- This is substantially below the Haringey (65.7%) and London (70%) averages.



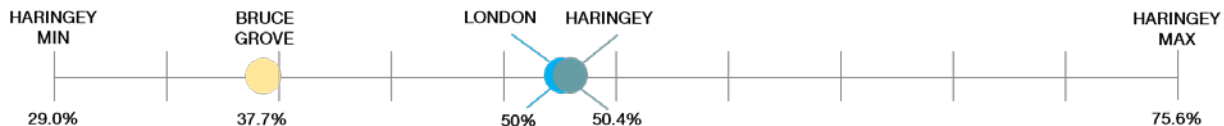
% PUPILS ACHIEVING GRADES 9-4 IN ENGLISH & MATHS, BRUCE GROVE

- In Bruce Grove, the proportion of pupils achieving grades 9-4 in English & Maths GCSEs (63%) is slightly below the Haringey and London averages (64.8% and 67.9% respectively).
- Bruce Grove is not amongst the lowest levels of pupils achieving grades 9-4 in English & Maths GCSEs in the borough.



% QUALIFICATIONS AT LEVEL 3 AND ABOVE, BRUCE GROVE

- In Bruce Grove, the proportion of residents with qualifications at level 3 or higher (37.7%) is substantially below the averages in both Haringey and London (50.4% and 50% respectively).
- Bruce Grove has the 3rd smallest proportion of residents with qualifications at level 3 or higher of all Haringey wards.

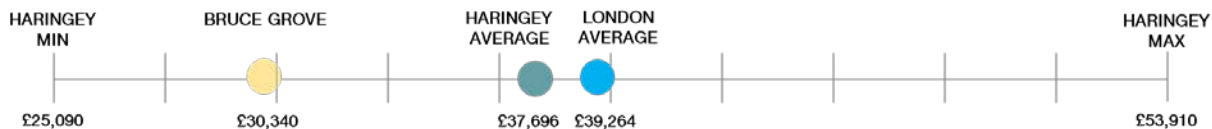

INCOME, EMPLOYMENT & TENURE

MEDIAN HOUSEHOLD INCOME, BRUCE GROVE

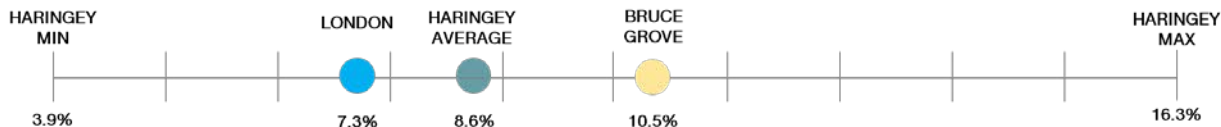
- The median household income in Bruce Grove is £30,340 a year. This is substantially lower than the Haringey (£37,696) and London (£39,264) averages.

UNEMPLOYMENT, BRUCE GROVE

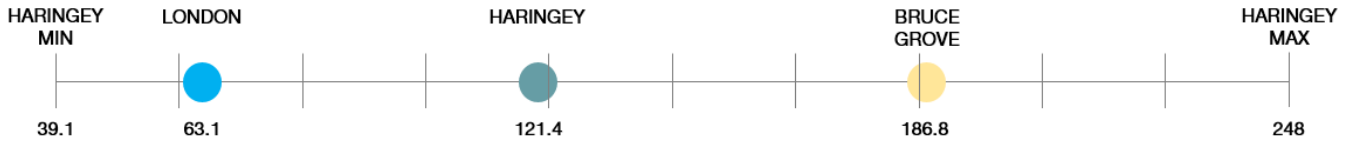
- 10.5% of Bruce Grove's residents are unemployed. This is higher than the Haringey (8.6%) and London (7.3%) averages.
- Bruce Grove has the fifth highest unemployment level of all Haringey wards.

JSA CLAIMANTS, BRUCE GROVE

- In Bruce Grove there are 186.8 JSA claimants for every 10,000 residents.
- This is substantially above both the Haringey and London levels (121.4 per 10,000 residents and 63.1 per 10,000 residents respectively), and is the second highest rate of all Haringey wards.
- The rate of JSA claimants in Haringey is almost double the London rate.

HOUSING TENURE, BRUCE GROVE

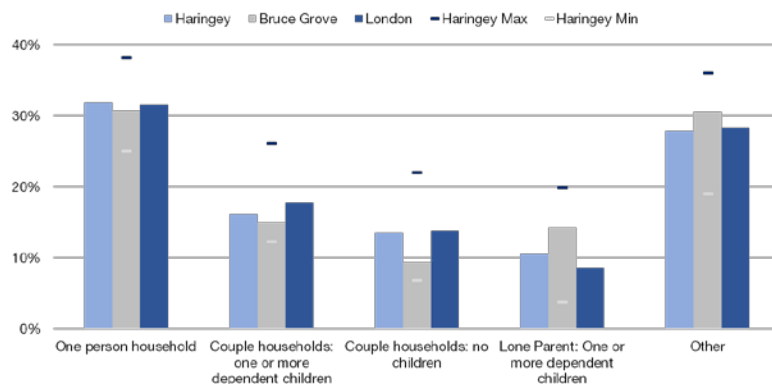
- Households in Bruce Grove are only slightly more likely to be owned (35.9%), rather than privately rented (32.2%) or socially rented (28.2%).
- On the whole patterns of tenure in Bruce Grove largely follow the wider Haringey pattern, with no tenure type particularly over- or under-represented in the ward.

HOUSEHOLD COMPOSITION, BRUCE GROVE

- Patterns of household composition in Bruce Grove largely follow the wider Haringey pattern, though Lone parent households with dependent children (14.3%) are slightly over-represented compared to the wider borough (10.5%), and Couple households with no children (9.4%) are slightly under-represented compared to Haringey (13.5%).

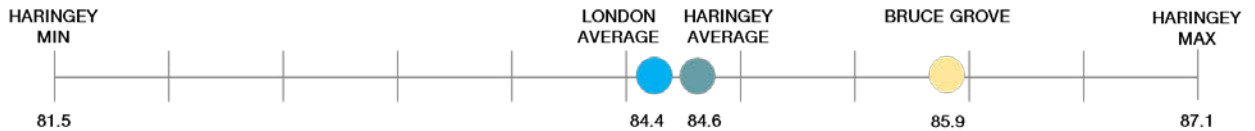

HEALTH, WELLBEING & CRIME

FEMALE LIFE EXPECTANCY, BRUCE GROVE

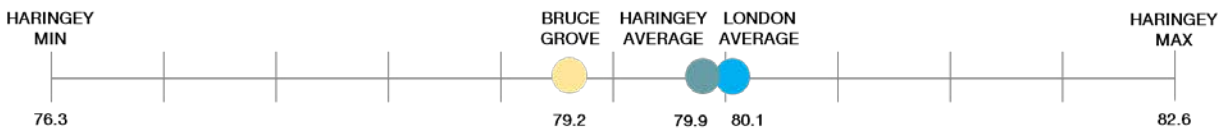
- Female life expectancy in Bruce Grove is 85.9 years, above both the Haringey (84.6) and London (84.4) averages.
- Bruce Grove has the 5th highest female life expectancy of all Haringey wards.

MALE LIFE EXPECTANCY, BRUCE GROVE

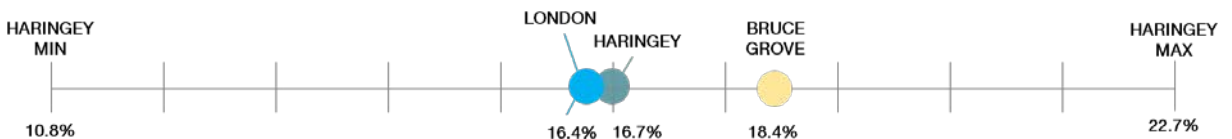
- Male life expectancy in Bruce Grove is 79.2 years, below the Haringey (79.9) and London (80.1) averages.

RESIDENTS WITH A LIMITING LONG-TERM HEALTH PROBLEM OR DISABILITY, BRUCE GROVE

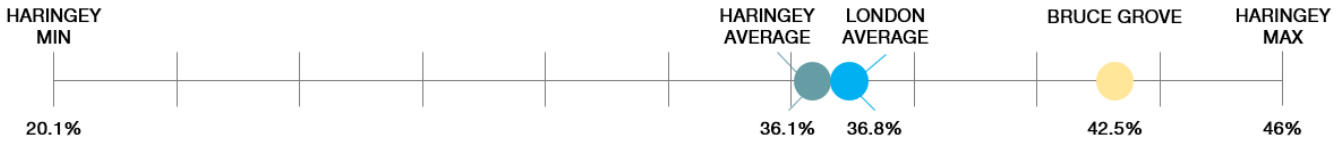
- In Bruce Grove 18.4% of residents have a limiting long-term health problem or disability. This is higher than the rate in either London (16.4%) or Haringey (16.7%), and is the fifth highest rate of all Haringey wards.

% PREVALENCE OF EXCESS WEIGHT IN YEAR 6, BRUCE GROVE

- 42.5% of Year 6 children in Bruce Grove have excess weight. This is above both the Haringey (36.1%) and London (36.8%) averages, but is not among the wards that have the highest levels of excess weight among children in Haringey.

RATE OF CRIME, BRUCE GROVE

- In Bruce Grove there were 211 crimes per 1,000 residents between February 2017 and January 2019 (this relates to any type of crime, from drug use or theft to violence against the person).
- This was slightly lower than the Haringey level and higher than London (224 per 1,000 residents and 187 per 1,000 residents respectively).
- The rate of crime in Haringey is more than 19% above the London rate.
